Understanding your transcript & credits

- ▶ Each class worth .5 credit
- ▶ Need 21 credits to graduate
- ▶ Testing requirements – met or not met
 - ▶ You will take these tests in 10th & 11th grade
- ▶ Washington State History – met or not met
 - ▶ If you took it in middle school, but your transcript says “not met” go see your counselor in room 105.

2020 Graduation Requirements:

- ▶ 4 credits Language Arts *with one year AP or CIHS*
 - ▶ 3.5 credits social studies & *Washington State History met*
 - ▶ 3 credits math + *1 for college*
 - ▶ 2 credits science + *1-2 for college*
 - ▶ 1.5 Occ. Ed./CTE & .5 Health
 - ▶ 1.0 Art (*2 classes in same category for many California colleges*)
 - ▶ 1.5 PE or waivers
 - ▶ 60 hours service learning – (*make it meaningful*)
 - ▶ Pass math, science and ELA state tests
 - ▶ 2 years same world language – *to apply to 4-year universities*
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Occupational Ed or CTE

- ▶ Business/Marketing
 - ▶ Computer Science/Web Design
 - ▶ Family and Consumer Sciences
 - ▶ Engineering
 - ▶ Leadership
 - ▶ Office Assistant

 - ▶ Seattle Public Schools Skills Center – offsite for ½ your day to train for a career

Ways to meet PE Requirement:

- ▶ Take PE class at RHS:
 - ▶ Yoga
 - ▶ Weight training
 - ▶ Team/Individual sports
 - ▶ Waivers:
 - ▶ Play at RHS – one season = one waiver
 - ▶ Academic waiver = full schedule of college prep/graduation requirements – see counselor for details
 - ▶ Sport/Activity outside of RHS – has to be a performance or test aspect to it
 - ▶ 80 hours logged on waiver form + signature = one waiver
