

Please note: Any course with an * requires a teacher's email approval.

Language Arts – Graduation Requirement – All 9th grade students will take this Language Arts course.

INTRO LIT ISSUE & COMP 9A/B (blocked) – This is required for graduation and is blocked with World History 1/2. Two teachers collaborate to integrate curriculum, and students stay together for two periods.

Social Studies – Graduation Requirement – All 9th grade students will take this Social Studies course.

WORLD HISTORY 1/2 (blocked) – this pairs up with the blocked Language Arts course.

Math – Graduation Requirement – Current SPS students will be placed according to district recommendation. Non-SPS students must select one these year-long courses:

ALGEBRA 1 A/B
ALGEBRA 2 A/B

GEOMETRY A/B
ALGEBRA 2 HONORS A/B

GEOMETRY HONORS A/B

Science – Graduation Requirement – All 9th grade students will take the required 9th grade courses:

PHYSICS PS / CHEMISTRY PS (These two courses are consecutive.)

For those students who think they have met all the requirements of the SPS required 9th grade science courses (curriculum including Chemistry and Physics), then they may sign up for: BIOLOGY 1/2. (Please email a copy of the 8th grade Science syllabus to Sci. Dept. Chair Jon Bonnelle at jabonnelle@seattleschools.org for his review and approval.)

If you have already taken a full year of high school level Biology, then you can select another science course:

BIOTECHNOLOGY 1/2 BIOTECHNOLOGY HONORS 1/2 ASTRONOMY 1/2
NW GEOLOGY (1 SEM) ECOLOGY (1 SEM)
CHEMISTRY 1/2 (Only if you are concurrently enrolled in Algebra 2 or higher)
PHYSICS 1/PHYSICS 2 (Only if you are concurrently enrolled in Algebra 2 or higher)

Health – Graduation Requirement – for all students. Roosevelt offers Health in 9th grade.

World Language – Graduation Requirement – You can select one of these year-long courses:

AMER SIGN LANG 1 A/B	FRENCH 1 A/B	SPANISH 1 A/B

Remember that two years of middle school World Language equals one year of high school World Language. Students coming to high school with two years of a World Language would select the second year of study in their specific language. If you are starting out and selecting the first year of a language, please mark down an alternate World Language on your course option worksheet. While we make every effort to give you your 1st choice, sometimes we need the alternate. World Language (or an alternate Personal Pathway) is a graduation requirement; we recommend that you start this during your freshman year.

Electives – You can select a number of these courses (some year-long, some semester long) to fill the remaining open boxes on the upper grid. These will be your primary elective choices. You should pick at least 4 alternate elective choices (list them on the lower grid). Please note: any course with an * requires a teacher’s email approval.
