SPREE INFORMATION

WHAT IS SENIOR SPREE NIGHT?

A fun and safe post-graduation, all-night party!

This Roosevelt tradition was established to offer a safe, substance-free environment for senior classmates to gather after their graduation ceremony. It is sponsored and chaperoned by RHS parents, and organized by "Grad Nights", who also provide on-site security.

When does Spree begin and end?

Following the graduation ceremony on June 19th, the Spree buses will pick up the students at Seattle Center EMP turn around at 10:00 pm (or approximately 20 minutes after the ceremony ends). The buses will deliver the graduates back to the RHS parking lot at approximately 6AM on June 20th.

How much does SPREE cost?

\$100. Thanks to fundraising by the class of 2018, the cost has been reduced to **\$100** if purchased before April 27. The Spree ticket price increases to **\$130** if purchased after April 27ⁿ. **Please note:** Scholarships are available (see **the counseling office** for more information).

What do the students do there?

Students are taken to two secret locations during the event where they will enjoy music, dancing, entertainment, soft drinks, games, midnight dinner and an early morning breakfast. The secrecy is critical to ensure the safety of the graduates that do attend.

HOW DO STUDENTS REGISTER FOR SPREE?

Students need to sign up during lunch (Commons Concession stand), on one of the following days:

Students need to bring the following to register:

- **Payment**— either by check for \$100 made out to *RHS PTSA CLASS OF 2018*, or printed proof of purchase made online at: www.2018rooseveltparents.gradnights.com
- **Completed parent signed agreement form**— "Grad Party Agreement" form can be found on the *RHS website* on the *Senior Events page*. NOTE: Students will not be allowed on the bus without a signed form.
- **Sign up for your bus** when you register. Sign up early to ride with your friends. **(You must pay and have signed agreement form before signing up for bus).**

What should your student bring?

Wear comfortable clothing (or bring a change of clothes), including shoes and socks. Purses are not recommended and will be searched. Toiletries and other amenities will be provided at the venues.

What is prohibited at SPREE?

Cell phones, drugs, alcohol, cigarettes of any type, weapons, backpacks and/or gym bags and water bottles are prohibited at Spree. Expensive electronic devices that might be lost are highly discouraged. If cell phones are brought, they will be collected when boarding the bus and returned back at RHS.
