Scholarships for Roosevelt Students Only

Golden Grads Scholarships – Ten scholarships will go to seniors who have demonstrated academic excellence, dedication to the Roosevelt community, school spirit, among other factors. Scholarship application will become available November 20th.

Roosevelt Class of 1962 Robbie Fahnstock Memorial Scholarship – Two \$2000 scholarships will be awarded to Roosevelt seniors who demonstrate financial need, have a 2.5 GPA or higher, and give back to their communities in a meaningful way, and plan to continue their education after high school graduation. Applications available in the RHS Counseling Office. Deadline **January 11, 2019**.

The Sandra Lynn Cohen Family – offers the **Sandra Lynn Cohen Academic Scholarship Memorial Fund**. The purpose of the SLCASMF is to provide a scholarship to a graduating student at **Roosevelt High School**. The scholarship is a one-time \$2,000 award, and may only be used for tuition and fees at the college of your choice. Awards are based on academic excellence, outdoor leadership, charitable activity, and financial need. Students may apply if they intend to at least earn their BA or BS degree, plan to immediately enroll in a 4 year college offering BA and/or BS degrees, and enroll at a college within the United States of America.
